Youth Director Position Description

Purpose / Benefits

- Youth of the church grow in their relationship with Christ through structured programming and fellowship
- Youth in the community and general area encouraged to join and be introduced and/or grow in their faith relationships with Christ, as well as COS
- COS gains more complete programming for families by providing specific youth related fellowship

Position Qualifications

- Exhibits a personal and growing relationship with Christ, with a healthy Godly lifestyle
- Demonstrates a commitment to an Orthodox Theology
- Demonstrates an understanding, and usefulness of communication styles, including social media, face to face, and facilitation
- Exhibits positive use and discernment of personal social media posts
- Demonstrates good relational skills with all ages
- Exhibits a strong “team player” ideal
- Formal education in youth ministry is preferred, not required.
- Previous experience in youth work is preferred
- A strong interest in Christian Education and assistance therein is helpful

Position Responsibilities

- Develop relationships with the youth in the congregation and with youth in the community
- Attend and connect with youth events and groups outside of COS
- Direct and plan regular youth activities for COS youth, that allows for exploration of, and/or growing in the faith. These activities should provide an environment for unchurched students to explore the faith, and, should be promoted through the church family, and in local schools when possible
- Recruit and train both student and adult leaders to share together in this ministry. Youth Director will not be responsible for leading every age group
- Attend periodic BOG meetings and/or PPRC, and Christian Education meetings for updates
- Utilize various forms of communication and available tools to communicate with youth, BOG, PPRC and the congregation (i.e. church newsletter, Sunday bulletin, oral updates during worship, social media, etc.)
- Attend, give and serve at COS
- Direct supervision of Youth Director is to the Pastor

Compensation

This part time position carries a salary of up to \$20,000 annually for 20 hours of work per week. Flexibility is needed for “school season hours” vs “summer” hours

- There are no health benefits, pay for absence, etc. associated with this position
