Job Title: Co-Minister of Youth

Reports to: Head of Staff, Rev. Dr. Anthony Osimo

Hours: 10 hours/week/person (looking to hire two people)

Compensation: Housing next to the campus of the church (Eight miles from Fuller Seminary)

General Description: The Ministers of Youth will focus many of their hours on building up both middle school and high school youth groups through the church. Since both groups are currently smaller, there will be a greater emphasis on outreach in the community and implementing creative ways to reach out to the youth not involved in the church. The goal is for the youth to have a community where they will be able to grow in their relationships with Christ and with each other, discover their own gifts and callings that God has given them, and serve together.

Organizational Relationship and Supervision: The Ministers of Youth will work together to run both middle school and high school youth ministries under the supervision of the Head of Staff and with the assistance/oversight of the Minister of Spiritual Formation and the Minister of Community. The Ministers of Youth will need to be married or two men or two women because of compensation of housing.

Job Responsibilities (to be divided between the two positions):

1. Develop, promote, and coordinate a balanced program of activities and discipleship ministry to youth in the church.
2. Meet with the youth as a group on a regular basis except for holidays and breaks
3. Create new ways to reach out to youth in our community to be involved in the church and ministry
4. Regularly lead times of prayer for and with the youth of the church.
5. Work in conjunction with the rest of the staff to incorporate youth into the life of the church (in worship services, service projects, outreach, etc.)
6. Be available to parents to discuss issues related to their child or youth ministry.
7. Participate in at least one service every Sunday (assignments are given by the Minister of Community on a weekly basis at staff meeting).
8. Attend weekly staff meeting.

Qualifications:

1. Passion and calling to work with youth
2. Minimum 2 years of youth ministry experience
3. Self-starter who enjoys building new ministries and programs
4. Bachelor's Degree
