Principal Function: The Organist is responsible for providing music support for the worship services, choir rehearsals and other services as requested.

Essential Functions:

- Play for the Sunday worship service, which is currently at 11:00 A.M.
- Accompany the Chancel Choir, and other ensembles as needed, and attend all rehearsals as scheduled.
- Play for other services or programs as requested by the Director of Traditional Worship, including any necessary rehearsals.
- Play for funerals/memorials services at the church upon request of the family. Financial compensation may be received from the family.
- Play for weddings as requested. Financial compensation for weddings will be paid by the family.
- Select appropriate music for church services and submit title/composer for Sunday bulletin.
- Devote appropriate practice time to be prepared for all rehearsals, Sunday mornings, and any other programs.
- Report maintenance/repair needs for the organ to the Director of Traditional Worship.

Experience and Educational Requirements:

- Five years of experience playing organ in a church
- Accomplished pianist/accompanist
- Good sight-reading skills
- Bachelor of Music or related degree desirable
