

Director of Youth Ministry Job Description

Are you creative and full of energy? Are you warm and outgoing? Do you have a passion for reaching youth and leading them into life changing relationship with Jesus? Morgan Hill Presbyterian Church is currently seeking just such a mature Christ follower to lead our youth ministry. Maybe it's you!

The position of **Director of Youth Ministry** will include, but not be limited to, the following duties:

- Running a weekly Friday night Junior High program (RAD).
- Re-Implementing and running a mid week Sr. High School program (ECHO)
- Implementing a College and Career Group
- Overseeing Sunday school for both Jr. and Sr. High School groups (the Living Room), including scheduling teachers and choosing and preparing curriculum.
- Organizing and Leading Mission trips, monthly service projects, retreats and involvement in appropriate church ministry opportunities (such as MAD Friday, MAD Camp, Christmas and Easter events, Genesis youth choir, etc...)
- Meeting with youth and parents on a regular basis to develop meaningful relationships.
- Continuing to develop and disciple Youth Leadership Team
- Seeking out ways to become involved in the greater Morgan Hill community in order to reach youth for Christ.
- Leading and recruiting volunteers for youth ministry
- Managing MHPC youth ministry social media and A/V
- Meeting with youth committee monthly, youth elders and pastor on a regular basis
- Attending weekly staff meetings and monthly session meetings
- Managing youth ministry budget, including scholarships and event fees, and permission slips and health forms.
- Being responsible for the youth room
- Continually evaluating effectiveness of programs with help of the youth committee and creating a vision for the growth of youth ministry
- Being involved in the greater life of MHPC and seeking to make youth ministry an integral part of the church's mission

Morgan Hill Presbyterian Church is an Evangelical Covenant Order of Presbyterians Church (**ECO**) and as such we hold to the essential tenets laid out in the ECO book of order. Any individual applying for this position must be willing to affirm these.

The Director of Youth Ministry should possess a **minimum** of a Bachelors Degree in Bible, Youth Ministry or similar from an evangelical institution and have a minimum of 2 years experience working with youth.

The Director of Youth Ministry will be **required** to:

- Complete MHPC Safe Church Training
- Provide proof of degree(s) obtained
- Provide references
- Provide a statement of faith
- Provide a statement of ministry vision
- Complete MHPC Director of Youth Ministry Job Application

The Director of Youth Ministry will report to and receive direction from the Elder for Youth Ministry and the Head of Staff.

This position is classified as regular full time. Compensation will be based upon education and experience.
