

Transitional (Interim) Pastor Opportunities

ECO is seeking applicants for Transitional Pastor positions to serve congregations throughout the denomination. ECO, A Covenant Order of Evangelical Presbyterians, is a Christian denomination whose theological and organizational heritage springs from the Reformed Presbyterian movements begun in 16th century Europe. ECO is a member of the World Communion of Reformed Churches and the National Association of Evangelicals.

Preferred qualifications of applicants include:

- A bachelor's degree (or equivalent) and a master's degree from an accredited theological seminary in biblical or theological studies.
- Ordination to pastoral ministry by a recognized Christian denomination.
- Experience as a transitional/interim pastor.
- Certification from a recognized provider of transitional/interim ministry training.
- Willingness to become a certified transitional/interim pastor.
- Availability to serve in a congregation for a minimum of one year.
- Willingness to receive, adopt and be bound by the Essential Tenets of the ECO.
- Willingness and ability to become a member, or affiliate member, of the presbytery in which the congregation to be served is located.
- Willingness to receive direct inquiries from presbyteries about your availability for service to a specific congregation.
