### Information & Application

#### **Goal of Missional Community Cohort:**

To equip a group of six to ten innovative CLP candidates or pastors into understanding and implementing Missional Communities in their local context. This Coaching Cohort is graciously being supported by ECO and the cost is \$750 per registration.

#### What Each Participating Church Will Receive from Innovations Labs:

- 7 Step process that is shared online through approximately 40 videos.
- 10 copies of the Field Notes handbooks.
- Participation in the private Church Innovation Lab Facebook page.
- Monthly online Missional Coaching Cohort meeting for one year, with Alex Absalom as the primary coach.

#### Benefits of The Cohort:

- Group members will have access to all of the resources of the Missional Community Starter Kit and Alex's professional and pastoral experience.
- Specific questions that are unique to your local context can be raised and addressed.
- Two 20-30 minute coaching sessions with Alex, for each registered participant.
- By being part of a cohort of peers, members will be both challenged and encouraged by the experiences of other group members, which will deepen learning and application.
- Group members will help create shared learning and experience that can serve the ECO family of churches, as well as the wider church.

#### **Expectations of Cohort Members:**

- Prioritize attendance at the coaching calls. If something genuinely comes up that prevents participation in a call, you are expected to call or text Alex Absalom in advance.
- Complete all assigned homework, including following through on next steps and goals.
- Recognize that this process is about far more than information transfer, and instead is focused on contextualized implementation. Change won't happen in a church if all you do is a monthly coaching call!
- Contribute to a high challenge and high encouragement environment, so that each person actively seeks to both give to and receive from their peers, as well as the group coach.
- Bring up clear questions, issues and queries, so that specific answers can be suggested for specific questions.
- Be willing to share with the wider ECO family your story of this journey, and the changes you see take place.
