OUR CHURCH

PCPC is a growing church family of 573 members with an average weekly attendance of 326 in 2021. We have a strong constituency of young families and retirees. We hold three Sunday morning worship services, offering traditional worship at 8:30 & 11:00 a.m. and contemporary worship at 9:30 a.m. Services are live streamed and available on our website and social media.

Our beautiful 8.2 acre campus includes:

- Sanctuary, which seats 500+
- Chapel, which seats 70
- Langill Hall, which includes a large, multipurpose space, full kitchen, and classrooms
- Nursery facilities
- Choir room
- Library, meeting rooms, and private offices
- Grounds, including a columbarium and memorial garden
- Huizenga Family Life Center, a multipurpose space, which includes a gymnasium, performance stage, and kitchen

PCPC was established in 1984 and was one of the original churches to join ECO in April 2012. The church budget for fiscal year 2022 was \$1.4 million.

There are many opportunities for growth, including discipleship and mentoring of new members from non-churched backgrounds.





OUR STATEMENT OF FAITH

What We Believe

- Jesus Christ is our living Savior. He lives and reigns, and someday he will make all things new.
- We receive a holy calling. Through his Holy Spirit, God claims us and makes us his own.
- We are a joyful community because following Jesus means a life of joy and belonging.
- We have a heart for others. The purpose of the church is to continue the ministry of Jesus until he returns.

We are evangelical and believe in the five solas of the Reformation.

- Faith Alone (Sola Fides) Protestants believe that faith in the work of Jesus Christ is the sole grounds for our justification before a holy God.
- Grace Alone (Sola Gratia) Faith that justifies us before a holy God is God's gift to us.
- Scripture Alone (Sola Sciptura) We believe in the authority of Scripture.
- Christ Alone (Solus Christus) Our salvation comes through the work of Christ alone.
- To God Alone Be the Glory (Soli Deo Gloria) God alone is worthy of our worship.

The purpose of PCPC is to take the mandate of Jesus Christ to be "fishers of men" as its mission.
